Dear Parent,

Congratulations and welcome to Bankstown Berries FC. Your son has been selected to represent the Berries in the NPL NSW Youth competition/SAP program.

This document is designed to provide preliminary information about the competition, team contacts, Training and the Berries/FNSW fee structure for the 2018 season.

The competition runs from March 2018 through to September 2018. Games are generally played on Saturday on home and away basis. This may change for various reasons eg wet weather and catch up games etc.

Training will be three times a week days to be advised youth/seniors.

You will be advised when training will commence and the venue it will be taking place once all trials and teams have been selected. Venue will be at the coach's discretion and attendance is mandatory.

Parents Concerns/ Complaints are to be addressed to team manager, not coach, who will in turn take it up with Youth convener and Youth technical Director.

If a player is requested to play up, they should oblige

All players are to stay and watch at least half a game of the older age

No parent shall make contact with coach or manager on game day

The Bankstown berries are not associated with any academies and request all their players not be associated with academies.

Behaviour

As part of this program all decisions on game time, positions and game tactics will be at the coach's discretion.

We encourage all parents to allow the coach to coach the team therefore no sideline instruction except from the coaching staff.

Players and parents will adhere to the FFA code of conduct attached. There will be no exceptions to this code and a condition of registration is that all players and parents adhere to this code.

Before registering club must be made aware of the below status.

- **Players must state if they intend to go on holidays during the season before registering.**
- **Players must state if school or any other activity will affect their training or game day situation before registering.**
- **Players must be at all training sessions.**
- **Players must attend all games even if they are injured.**
- **Player must make themselves available on game day to play up an age group if required.**

Game day

Players will arrive at designated venue 1 hour prior to scheduled kick off. It is a player's responsibility to bring the appropriate uniform and equipment. Players will wear what the Berries will supply them for game day. We encourage all to stay and support the next game.

Parents

Bankstown Berries FC is a voluntary organisation and we require assistance with duties throughout the year.

Some of the duties will include canteen and ground set up. The SAP- U/12 parents will be setting the field and the U/18 will be packing up the field on home game day. We will roster the parents on game day for canteen duty.

Sponsorship

The club will be handing out sponsorship details in a bid to raise funds for the continued development of the Berries FC junior footballers. These packages are affordable and each level comes with benefits for the sponsor.

Fund raising

The club will be upgrading facilities at Thurina park by upgrading clubhouse with repositioning canteen to front of clubhouse and with new cooking equipment we will also be installing an injury rehabilitation room and equipment this will add on top of the fees another \$200- for the youth and \$200- for the SAP and is payable upon registration.

Fee Structure

Fees for the 2018 season are as follows. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FULL AMOUNT IS PAYABLE UPON REGISTRATION. ONCE THE FEES HAVE BEEN PAID THERE WILL BE NO REFUND WHATEVER THE SITUATION.**

NPL NSW Youth fee's payable for the season are \$2400.00 Inc GST.

SAP fee's payable for the season is \$1500.00 Inc GST
